

Range Rules

This is a MEMBERS ONLY Range

Members must adhere to the Range Rules or disciplinary action up to and including loss of Membership may occur.

- 1. While on Club property, <u>Members MUST</u> display their Club ID and <u>Members MUST</u> also have another form of identification (photo ID preferred) in their possession.
- 2. Shooting hours are from 10 AM until Sunset prevailing time, no exception.
- 3. Upon arriving at the range, Members Must complete the Log-in Sheet. Members bringing a Guest Must also complete the guest section of the Log-in Sheet. All Guests Must fill out and sign a Waiver. Shooting Guests Must Pay a Guest Fee. Observing Guests do not pay a fee but Must fill out and sign a Waiver. Guests under the age of 18 whether shooting or observing Must sign a Waiver but the fee is waived. Members Must verify accurate completion of the Guest Waiver, sign the waiver form, collect the Guest Fee if applicable and place the Guest Waiver and Guest Fee in the Guest Waiver & Fee Lockbox.

 Members may bring no more than two Guests to the Range per visit and Members Must at all times have total control of the Guests and/or the children the Member brings to the Range.
- 4. No one is allowed down range when any of the covered shooting areas are in use.
- 5. DOWN RANGE SAFETY PROCEDURE.
 - A. Unload your firearm and leave the action open.
 - B. Make contact with all shooters present and agree it is safe to go down range.
 - C. Activate the Down Range Alert System by turning the switch on. A light will flash, and a horn will sound.
 - D. Take an Orange Safety Cone and place it at least 15 yards down range even when shooting the 5-yard pistol backer.
 - E. After hanging your paper targets, return the Orange Safety Cone to its proper location, turn off the Down Range Alert System and inform all shooters the Range is now Hot.
 - F. No Guest is allowed down range without a Member accompanying the Guest.
- * Before any Member goes down range all shooters must unload their firearms and leave the actions open *
- **The Orange Safety Cone and Down Range Alert System MUST BE USED even if there is only one Member using the Range**
- 6. <u>Members may only bring paper targets to the range.</u> The Club may from time to time provide targets such as steel, self-healing, etc. When done shooting clear your targets from the backerboards and collect your brass from the ground.
- 7. <u>NO RAPID FIRING or DOUBLE TAPS are allowed.</u> HLR&GC defines Rapid Firing as shooting more than one round every two seconds. <u>NO "QUICK DRAW"</u> practicing.
- 8. No "fully-automatic" firearms allowed on the Club grounds.
- 9. The discharge or use of guns chambered in 50 BMG (Browning Machine Gun) or similar calibers is prohibited.
- 10. <u>"Duds"</u> that Members don't take home <u>Must be disposed of in the 'Dud Boxes"</u> provided at the Pistol and Rifle Ranges. <u>DO NOT throw Duds or live ammunition in trash receptacles, leave it on benches or the ground.</u>
- 11. Trap Shooting is allowed on the Trap Range only.
- 12. All Shotguns using shot shells and Pistols using self-defense loads Must use the Shotgun Pattern Range.
 - A. Steel Plate Grease Board. For use of lead shot only. No steel shot, slugs, buckshot, or home/self-defense rounds. Do not shoot the Steel plate closer than 30 yards.
 - B. Wire Board. For use of steel shot, slugs, buckshot, or home/defense rounds. Clip your paper targets to the wire.
